FEES

- \$50 entry fee per tournament
- Any bowler may participate

QUALIFYING TOURNAMENTS

- There will be five qualifying tournaments and one finals tournament.
- All tournaments are subject to entry fees.
- Must sign up seven days prior to the event. No late sign-ups or walk-ins will be accepted.
- Must bowl three of the five qualifying tournaments to qualify for the finals tournament.
- Entries will be limited to 120 bowlers. Once all entries have been filled for a tournament, Island Xtreme Bowl will not accept any more entries into that tournament.
- You may request a lane assignment, but your lane may change based on turnout.
- You may request a team to bowl together, but Island Xtreme Bowl reserves the right to split teams up to accommodate all bowlers.
- Doors open at 8am, check-in starts at 9am and practice starts at 10am.

HANDICAP

- Handicap will be 80% of 200 with a max of 48 per game (140 lowest average).
- 300 maximum score per game with handicap.
- Must be USBC (United States Bowling Congress) sanctioned and have a verifiable average OR have a non-verifiable average and bowl scratch (without handicap).
- Must use highest USBC average from current or previous year based on 21 games within the same league year.
- If you don't have 21 games within the same league year, you must bowl scratch.
- All handicaps will be verified the day of the tournament.
- All entrants must have a photo ID, and the name and face must match the information provided to Island Xtreme Bowl for USBC average.
- Each entrant will bowl three games of qualifying play.
- The top 24 bowlers (score with handicap), will move onto match play. In the event of a tie for a qualifying spot in match play, please follow the shoot-out rules.





MATCH PLAY (Qualifying Tournaments)

- Match play is single elimination.
- The top 24 qualify for match play in qualifying tournaments only.
- The top three bowlers after three rounds of match play will compete for the top three payouts for that day's tournament.
- The top three bowlers will bowl one game for first, second and third. There are no ties.
- In the event of a tie in match play or qualifying for match play, the tournament director will implement a shoot-out that consists of each bowler shooting the 9th and 10th frame. The highest scratch score wins. The tournament director will decide what lane the shoot-out bowlers start on.
- The top 12 bowlers in each tournament will be paid.
- Payouts will be determined by the number of entrants for each individual tournament.

MATCH PLAY (Finals Tournament)

- The top 10 point earners from the previous five qualifying tournaments will automatically move to the top 24 match play in finals week. To round out the top 24 bowlers for finals match play, the top 14 bowlers of finals day qualifying will move on to the top 10 point earners from the five qualifying tournaments.
- Any bowler who has bowled in three qualifying tournaments will be invited back to the finals tournament, no matter what their season-ending point total is.
- Any bowler who wants to bowl in the finals tournament may bowl, but they will not be eligible for any prize money. They can still participate in "brackets"; the entry fee will still be \$50.
- All other previously listed match play rules will stay in effect.

EQUIPMENT

- Bowling equipment must comply with all current USBC rules.
- The use of non-compliant equipment during any Island Xtreme Bowl tournament will result in automatic disqualification. No refunds will be given for disqualification.
- A ball scale will be available equipment.





LANES

- A different oil pattern will be used for every tournament.
- Island Xtreme Bowl will use Kegel lane patterns, and all oil patterns will be consistent with USBC standards.
- Island Xtreme Bowl will “burn” the first pair of lanes off to make each pair of lanes equal.

POINTS EARNED BY TOURNAMENT BY PLACE

1st: 50 points

2nd & 3rd: 40 points

4th-6th: 30 points

7th-12th: 25 points

13th-24th: 20 points

25th & Below: 5 points

Qualifying leader add 20 points

The guaranteed first place payout is a one-time payout that will only occur in the finals tournament. All other qualifying tournament payouts will be determined by the number of entrants in that tournament.

The tournament director will use the current USBC rules for guidance.

The tournament director reserves the right to refuse any entrant and has final say in all decisions.
